

Are you an older carer supporting someone with disability?



The National Community Connector Program provides information and support to older carers of people with disability to improve their NDIS experience and outcomes for the person they care for.

The Community Connector Program aims to:

- Increase understanding and reduce barriers in accessing the NDIS
- Support carers in gathering evidence to assist with accessing the NDIS
- Support in completing an NDIS Access Request Form
- Support in appealing an NDIS access decision
- Connect ageing carers to the broader system of supports for people with a disability, including NDIS partners in the community such as Local Area Coordination and Early Childhood Early Intervention providers.

The program is available for ageing parents and carers of people with disability.

Ageing means people over 65 years or over 50 years for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people or prematurely aged people.

People with disability means a person under 65 years.

The National Community Connector Program (NCCP) is funded by the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) and is being delivered by Carers NSW, through Carer Gateway across Hunter New England, the Central Coast and North Coast of NSW.
