#### **Who is eligible?**

Young aged 25 or under who live in or near Hurstville, Burwood, Ashfield, Blacktown, Parramatta, Bankstown, Fairfield, Liverpool, Campbelltown, Camden, Penrith, Richmond or the Blue Mountains and receive the Carer Payment or Carer Allowance.
