Since moving to Sydney in 1994, Jodi divides her time between teaching, coaching, adjudicating and public speaking.*

*In 2012, Jodi cared for her husband Olympic swimming legend Murray Rose. The final months of his life became Jodi's greatest test, but one that gave her inner strength. She is deeply committed to the cause of opening up dialogues about the universal topics of caring, death and grief worldwide.*
