Fee-Free* TAFE NSW in 2023

Fee-free* training is a joint initiative of the Australian and New South Wales Governments, providing tuition-free study options for people wanting to train, retrain or upskill.

<u>TAFE NSW fee-free* courses</u> are available for people who enrol after 1 December 2022 and commence their course between 1 January 2023 and 31 December 2023.

TAFE NSW provides more than 300 qualifications from certificates to diplomas that align to the state's priority industry growth sectors, free of tuition fees for eligible students.

TAFE NSW Study Seeker Course Quiz

The TAFE NSW <u>Study Seeker Quiz</u> is available on the TAFE NSW website if you are uncertain about which course would be suitable for you. The quiz is a series of 13 short questions that will guide you to explore specific career paths.

If you have not studied for some time and would like to gain skills and confidence, TAFE NSW has hundreds of <u>Short Courses</u>, including study options for online delivery that can offer practical skills and experiences across all industries in just days or weeks.

Assistance while you are studying at TAFE NSW

The TAFE NSW <u>counselling and career development service</u> is free and is designed to help you with strategies to get the most from your course and with your studies, as well as in your chosen career. Prospective TAFE NSW students can access the service to assist with course choice decisions and career planning. Enrolled students can access a range of services to assist in career development and personal support.

TAFE NSW also provides a range of additional <u>support services</u> while you are studying, including accessibility and disability services, Aboriginal student support, international student support, multicultural student support, learner support, financial assistance, and access library services.

Scholarships

The <u>Mature Aged scholarship</u> is available for people who are 35 or older, looking for work and wanting to retrain or upgrade skills.

TAFE NSW also has a range of additional <u>scholarships</u> available to students.

Studying at TAFE NSW can help you get back into the workforce or stay ahead of evolving skill needs. You may be eligible for a fee-free* place in a Smart and Skilled Certificate II, Certificate III or Certificate IV qualification.
